

Lay presentation

This prize competition has been run by lay members of the Barrett's Oesophagus Campaign (BOC) over the past 3 years and has been highly stimulating and prestigious. Any researcher (not principal investigator) is invited to submit a summary of their work in language understandable to a lay person. A committee from BOC will score and shortlist the best 3 abstracts which will be presented orally at the meeting. Each presenter will receive a prize towards travel to an international conference.

Scientific presentation

At the meeting there will be scientific presentations given as orals and posters. These may contain information about clinical or basic laboratory research. This can contain similar information to the lay presentation but the language should reflect the target audience (lay judge or scientific colleague respectively). The abstracts will be peer reviewed and you will be invited to present a poster or talk according to the number and quality of abstracts submitted. There will also be prizes for the scientific presentations.
